An exciting opportunity has arisen to work in a stem cell research programme funded by the Arthritis Research Campaign (arc). We seek a highly motivated, enthusiastic, and skilled research fellow with experience in stem cell research and in vivo models. Preference will be given to candidates with experience in models of musculoskeletal disorders such as osteoarthritis, with a demonstrable research output.

This is an exciting post within the Regenerative Medicine Unit (<http://www.abdn.ac.uk/ims/bone/research/regenerative/>) of the multidisciplinary Bone & Musculoskeletal Research Programme (<http://www.abdn.ac.uk/ims/bone>) in the state-of-the-art Institute of Medical Sciences (<http://www.abdn.ac.uk/ims>), funded through an arc project grant. You will work closely with Professor Cosimo De Bari and his Regenerative Medicine Unit and will be expected to interact with other researchers of the Programme.

To be successful in this post you must have a PhD in a biological or medical science. Experience in stem cell biology, immunohistochemistry and in vivo models is essential. Whilst experience in molecular biology, mouse genetics and developmental biology is desirable.

As this post is funded by arc it will be offered for a period of 3 years.

Salary will be at the appropriate point on the Grade 6 scale (£29,704 - £31,513 per annum), with placement according to qualifications and experience.
