These analyses are performed for all the ARI research groups, GCTM Pre-Clinical Division (CRO) and the external research groups collaborating with the ARI. The Tissue Morphology Focus Area is one of the key service provider teams within the ARI. As such, it is presently staffed with 2 senior technicians, two junior technicians and 2 medical fellows.
